

SEASONAL SHUTDOWN

Once the seasons change and things start to cool down it is time to shutdown your equipment. We have put together this guide to help make sure your shutdown goes smooth.



Seasonal shutdown is important to maintaining your media and equipment. When you do not follow the steps for shutdown it can cause damage to your equipment and shorten the life of you media. Here are your 5 steps to seasonal shutdown:

SEASONAL SHUTDOWN TIPS:



1 Drain all the water to keep from freezing.



2 Clean out the media with fresh water and let dry.



3 Clean out spray headers to keep from later buildup.



4 Do an other all check up of pumps, sumps, switches, etc. Be sure to cycle clean water through system and drain properly.



5 Put all the dry parts together and store in a safe covered place (if possible)
